

## Language, literacy and communication

### Skills

- Appraise a text or image deciding on its quality, value and usefulness.
- In responses, children identify key features, themes and characters and select relevant words, phrases or images to support their view.

### Activities/Resources

- Still image of opening scene from Carrie's War. Children asked to make initial observations and activate prior knowledge.
- Children record observations in pairs around image. Add ideas about the setting – when and where and characters in the story.

## Information Communication Technology

### Skills

- Appraise a text or image deciding on its quality, value and usefulness – evacuee images on BBC website.
- Create, capture and manipulate an image/ sound for inserting into word processing.

### Activities/Resources

- Follow on from Carrie activity – gathering more information from a slide show of stills. Evaluate range of pictures/ images and decide how useful they are. Do they show the real story? Where else could we look for information – compare with text.
- War poem based on observations with image background and voice sound-over.

## Developing thinking

### Skills

- Plan – APK identify and make links with prior skills and knowledge.
- Plan – ask questions and listen before asking further questions.
- Develop – form opinions and make decisions.
- Consider evidence and distinguish between fact, belief and opinion.

### Activities/Resources

- On Carrie image, children record prior knowledge of evacuation – in pairs, think pair share. Then snowball results in class and add to images.
- Write questions about image and suggest ways of finding the answers.
- Look at variety of images and make decisions about the feelings of evacuees – how they were treated, were they happy, etc.

## Other curriculum area(s)

### Skills

- Ask and answer relevant questions and evaluate historical sources.
- Recognise that the past is represented and interpreted in a variety of ways.
- All previous skills will link to history topic.

### Activities/Resources

- All the activities have been planned through topic work – history.
- Outcomes will be a report on evacuees in their e-books and a narrative following Carrie's War.
- Also comparing film sequences with extracts of the book.
